Volunteers to Assemble Care Packages for Youth Enrolled in AFFCF's Post-Secondary Program

CHANDLER, Ariz. – On Tuesday, April 14, [Arizona Friends of Foster Children Foundation](#) will partner with [Subaru Superstore of Chandler and community volunteers](#) to assemble care packages for foster youth enrolled in the nonprofit's [Post-Secondary program](#), which serves young adults aged 18-26 pursuing higher education. A team of community volunteers and staff members from AFFCF will be present to assist with the packing effort. The event's goal is to prepare 120 care packages containing a variety of practical everyday items, inspirational books or journals, along with snacks and encouraging letters from community members. Employee volunteers with Subaru Superstore of Chandler have hosted care package packing parties with AFFCF for 16 semesters, timing their efforts near finals season to ensure students with foster care experience feel supported and prepared while studying.

AFFCF Post-Secondary Program managers and volunteers with Subaru will be available to talk about the impact of the partnership for former foster students, how the Post-Secondary Program works, and how to support AFFCF if interested in contributing to the care package effort.

WHY: Care packages are being assembled for 120 youth in foster care currently enrolled in AFFCF's Post-Secondary programming, which supports youth who are currently in or aged out of foster care who are enrolled in a post-secondary or vocational program. Program participants have access to scholarships and emergency expense funds, as well as tuition assistance.
